



## Friday, October 3 – CEEC Partner Program Delft, The Netherlands

### 09:00 – 10:00 | Short city tour from Hotel Arsenaal

- Start at the hotel, walk along the canals towards the Vermeer Centrum.
- Coffee at KEK Delft.

### 10:00 – 11:40 | Vermeer Centrum Delft (€12,-)

- Visit the Johannes Vermeer museum.  
The only place in the world to see all 37 of Vermeer's paintings as full-size reproductions, tracing his artistic journey.
- Duration: approx. 60 min. + time for the museum shop.

### 11:40 – 12:00 | Walk to Koornmarkt (canal tour jetty)

- Only a 5-minute walk.  
A short detour along Oude Delft 107 reveals a hidden historic courtyard, before continuing to the Koornmarkt for the canal cruise.

### 12:00 – 15:45 | Delft Blue Line Canal Tour + visit Royal Delft (€27,50)

- Canal boat tour to Royal Delft (departure from Koornmarkt, approx. 45 min).  
Discover Delft's historic canals and hidden gems from the water, with live or audio-guided commentary.
- Visit the Royal Delft factory, museum + museum shop.  
The last remaining 17th-century Delftware factory, where craftsmen still create the world-famous Delft Blue by hand.
- Lunch at Brasserie 1653 at Royal Delft

### 15:45 – 16:00 | Return by boat or optional walk

- We will be picked up again by boat at 15:45. Return to Koornmarkt.
- Alternatively, walk back via the typical courtyards and picturesque streets (approx. 25 min).

### 16:00 – 17:00 | optional activities

- Enjoy some:
  - Shopping (many shops have extended hours on Fridays)
  - Have a drink in a cozy café
  - Return to Hotel Arsenaal to relax before dinner



## Saturday, October 4 – Delft Morning Program

**Starting point: Hotel Arsenaal, Delft**

### **09:15 – 10:00 | Weekly Market & Antique Market at the Markt**

- Weekly market and antique market are very close to the hotel (5-minute walk). Browse local delicacies, flowers, antiques, and vintage finds in the heart of Delft.
- City Hall and surrounding look at the historic facades.

### **10:00 – 10:45 | Oude Kerk Delft (Old Church)**

- Visit the Gothic church, known as the “Old John” with its leaning tower. It’s the resting place of Johannes Vermeer and other historic figures.
- From the Markt it’s about a 5-minute walk to the Oude Kerk.

### **10:45 – 11:30 | Nieuwe Kerk Delft (New Church)**

Walk back towards the Markt through picturesque streets and visit the Nieuwe Kerk. Famous for its impressive Gothic architecture and as the burial place of the Dutch royal family, and the tomb of William of Orange.

### **11:30 – 12:45 | Courtyards walk and shopping**

- Explore the courtyards around the Markt, such as Voldersgracht and Doelenstraat. Discover Delft’s hidden hofjes – peaceful historic courtyards tucked away behind old facades.
- Visit boutiques, Delft Blue shops and local delicatessen stores.

### **13:00 | Lunch at Arsenaal**
